GIFTS FROM GOD/ STEWARDSHIP (CAFOD Universal Church unit)

Revelation

- Responses to creation (e.g. in prayer, art, music etc.);
- care for and misuse of God's creation;
- God's call to people in the Old Testament;

Celebration

- Their freedom to choose and the responsibility to choose the God
- The practice of examination of conscience and its significance for Christian living

Life in Christ

- the diversity and richness of creation;
- the values of sharing, showing respect and care for others

THE COMMANDMENTS

Revelation

- God's call to people in the Old Testament;
- The Gospel accounts of key events in the life of Jesus: Nativity

Life in Christ

- The Gospel message that Jesus brings fullness of life for all people: the Beatitudes
- How love of God is shown in obedience to God's commandments
- Sunday as the Lord's day
- Ways love of neighbour can be shown at home, at church, locally and globally
- The Christian values which inform love of neighbour and oneself

INSPIRATIONAL PEOPLE

Revelation

- How Jesus called people to follow him

The Church

- The cost of discipleship

RECONCILIATION

Celebration

- Jesus' attitudes to sinners and his teachings about sorrow and forgiveness
- The Rite of Reconciliation and its significance

Life in Christ

- Sin as a failure of love and the love and mercy of God which calls people to sorrow and forgiveness

LIFE IN THE RISEN JESUS

Celebration

- Prayer in the life of Jesus
- The prayers Jesus taught his friends (Our Father) and its significance
- A variety of prayers and prayer forms, formal and informal used for personal and community prayer

Life in Christ

- The suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus as a sign of love, sacrifice and the source of new life
- Conscience as a gift to be developed through the practice of examination of conscience

PEOPLE OF OTHER FAITHS

Celebration

- Respect for celebrations of the Jewish faith and other religions and appreciation that prayers has a place for their followers

Life in Christ

- Respect for community values and life of other cultures and other religious communities

THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Revelation

- Ways in which people of today can hear and respond to God's call

The Church

- God's call to individuals and their different responses
- Respect for the writings and holy people of the Jewish faith and other religions

Life in Christ

- Accounts in scripture of God's invitation and a variety of responses.
- Ways in which care for other is important for the Jewish faith and other religions

JUSTICE/ COMMON GOOD (CAFOD Universal Church unit)

Revelation

- The Gospel accounts of key events in the life of Jesus: Nativity

Life in Christ

- The motives and emotions which influence choices

JESUS, SON OF GOD

Revelation

- Resurrection and ascension
- The Gospel accounts of how the lives of men and women were changed by their encounters with Jesus
- Presentation, finding in the Temple, baptism, temptations, passion, death

JESUS, THE BREAD OF LIFE

Celebration

- The Church's celebration of significant events in the life of Jesus Christ
- The structure of the Eucharist
- The significance of the Church's names for the Sacrament of Mass, Eucharist, The Lord's Supper, the breaking of bread

THE WORK OF THE APOSTLES

Revelation

- The Gospel accounts of the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and the transformation of the disciples

The Church

- The gifts of the Holy Spirit which are given to individuals and groups for the service of the whole community

- The life and growth of the first Christian communities (e.g. Paul, Stephen)
- The teaching role of the apostles (e.g. through the New Testament letters)
- The cost of the discipleship

CALLED TO SERVE

Celebration

- The rite of Confirmation and the response it invites
- Be able to name the Sacraments of Holy Orders and Matrimony and explain their significance in their own words
- Ways in which love and commitment are important on human life
- The Sacrament of the Sick
