Health UK Advisory

The Chief Medical Officer for Health UK recommends that children and adults should take a daily supplement containing 10mg a day of **Vitamin D**, especially during the winter months. Vitamin D helps develop and to keep bones, teeth, muscles and the immune system healthy.

Vitamin D is the sunshine vitamin. On average 20 minutes of sunshine every day – not easy for most of the year! Vitamin D can be found naturally in oily fish, red meat, liver, egg yolks and fortified foods such as margarines and breakfast cereals. However you would have to eat lots and lots of these foods to get all the Vitamin D you need. Vitamin D supplements can be bought from pharmacies and supermarkets.
