Mathematics

(You must complete this activity)

- MyMaths activity – available on Friday.
- Find an example of when money is linked to time e.g. supermarket car park.
- Plan a day trip and work out how much it may cost you (imaginary/real).

English – Writing, GPS or Spelling

(You must complete this activity)

- Spellings – High frequency word challenge – learn the words in your spelling log book weekly.

- Learn a poem about any area of the topic below and recite it to someone at home. Ask them to write a review or comment about your performance.

English – Reading

(You must complete this activity)

- Visit a library and read to an adult.
- Find an unusual place to read and ask someone to take a photograph as evidence.
- Draw a picture from your favourite book.
- Read every day.

- Find out about Jocelyn Curry and create a fact file about her.
- Create a piece of artwork based on the work of Jocelyn Curry.

- Investigate turning a solid into a liquid and back again.
- Identify types of solids, liquids and gases.
- Create a mould by changing a liquid into a solid.

Topic

- Create an Egyptian artefact e.g. scroll or headdress.

- Take photos of natural water features.
