Mathematics

- Use one of your family shopping lists to create a bar chart to represent the countries that each item on it originates from.
- Take photographs of shapes that you come across while you're out and about.
- Practice Times Tables as a family and link to multiples of 10, 100, 1,000 and division of 10, 100 and 1,000 (6 x 7; 6 x 70; 6 x 700; 6 x 7,000; 0.6 x 7; 0.06 x 7; 0.006 x 7).

***MATHLETICS.** Complete the following assigned activities: **number and place value; add and subtract; multiply and divide.** Once you've completed these tasks, all activities will become accessible. - Visit a traditional cuisine restaurant (Chinese, Indian, Thai) and write a review. With adult supervision, post it on a review website.
- Tell 'The Legend of Beowulf' through a 6/8 section comic strip.
- Write in role as an Anglo- Saxon coming to Britain for the first time.

Reading

- Research Fair Trade: What is it? Why is it necessary? Who started it? Which countries are involved?
- Learn by heart a traditional Folk Tale.
- Read a classic (Oliver, Frankenstein, A Christmas Carol, Treasure Island)
- Sign up to your local library and take out a book.
- Read 'The Legend of Beowulf'.

Make a globe and identify 'Fair Trade' countries.

Science

Design and label model to depict The Water Cycle

Art

Design and make an Anglo- Saxon Roundhouse or Fort

Design and make a tapestry depicting a scene from The Legend of Beowulf.
