


# St. Anthony's Little Church

## Put Out Into Deep Water



Jesus called Peter, James and John to something completely different to what they knew. When he said, 'Put out into the deep', Jesus was saying, 'I am taking you into unknown territory, into something you are not familiar with; but I will bring great things out of this if you trust me.' The Lord says something similar to us. Life is a constant 'launching out', being taken out of comfort zones and experiencing a loss of control. The Lord is telling us not to be afraid of 'deep waters', of the unknown, of what can be very frightening. He is with us. Not only that, but if we trust him, He can bring great good out of it. To enable us to grow, God often has to lead us to places and situations that we would rather avoid.

## CAFOD in Venezuela



Venezuela has a population of around 31 million people. Over the past few years, thousands of people have been seeking refuge in neighbouring countries due to skyrocketing prices caused by the decreasing price of Venezuela's biggest export - oil, which makes up around 95% of exports. During the early 2000s, when oil prices were high, oil profits were used to reduce inequality and poverty. When oil prices dropped in 2014, the government suddenly had to make lots of cutbacks. This led many people to begin buying goods on the black market, causing inflation to rise. Monsignor Héctor Fabio Henao, director of Caritas Colombia, explains how the organisation has been supporting Venezuelans who have crossed the border into Colombia. He said: "The Catholic Church has been on the frontline supporting Venezuelans who arrive by providing food, shelter and emergency aid while working alongside governments across Latin America to do more."
