## Mathematics

(You must complete these activities)

- Explore different pairs of numbers that total to make 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.
- Learn by heart your 2, 5 and 10 multiplication table. Time yourself reciting them and record your time as it improves.
- Set up a 'play shop' with other family members. Label objects and items with prices and practise paying for 2/3 items and giving change using real coins.

## English – Writing, Phonics

(You must complete these activities)

- Write a recount about a family celebration you have attended.

## English – Reading

(You must complete these activities)

- **Read your two books each week. Try to read a little every day and ask an adult to record it.**

## History

Look into the origins of your family and your family surname.  
Talk to different generations of your family about their favourite toy.  
Create a timeline to show the changes in toys in living history.
