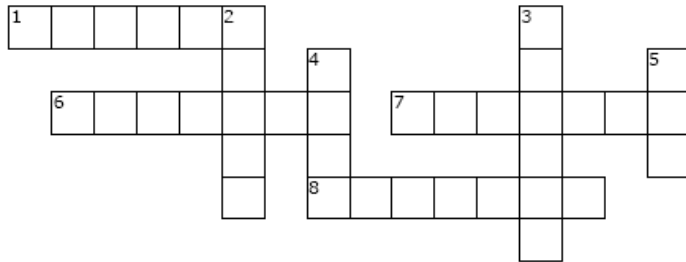


# St. Anthony's Little Church

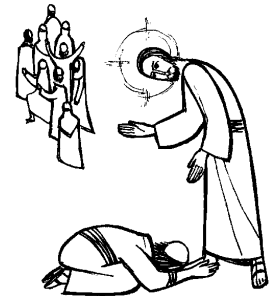

## Why bother saying 'Thank-you'?

According to the Law of Moses, anyone infected with leprosy was rendered unclean and excluded from the community. Ten lepers came to Jesus for healing and it seems he simply told them to go and show themselves to the priest for confirmation that they had been healed. He needed only to say the word. Only a Samaritan, who was despised as a heathen "foreigner," returned to Jesus to give thanks. While the others were healed of their physical affliction, this man was also saved from the leprosy of sin.
