



As a Catholic FairAware School we understand the importance of supporting others in the world that are less fortunate than ourselves. This year the Fairtrade Foundation has been campaigning to raise awareness of climate change and how this affects the livelihood of many people around the world. Extreme weather conditions, such as drought, heavy rainfall, rising sea levels have massive impacts on crop productivity and therefore people's income.

We want to help and play our part in raising awareness about the impact of climate change by making little changes, so we are asking for your support with two campaigns.

1. 'Stuff a bottle'



As you know non-recyclable plastics are thrown into landfill sites or even worse, don't make it that far and end up in our local environment. We want to try to reduce this by asking you to undertake the 'Stuff a bottle' challenge at home. Each class is competing against each other to stuff as many large bottles as they can with non-recyclable plastics, for example fruit netting, fruit film lids, frozen food packaging, cling film etc. Once you've stuffed a bottle take a photo to show your teacher then you'll be able to record it on your class chart. The class with the most bottle stuffed by Fri 9th July will receive some Fairtrade treats.

Please note, do not bring the bottles into school.

2. Green & Blue bottle top lids & Fairtrade logos



We also want you to collect blue and green coloured bottle top lids and any Fairtrade logos that you might find on food packaging. We are going to reuse them to create a large Fairtrade logo collage so please get saving those lids and cut out the logos and drop them into a collection tin in school.
