Mathematics

- Learning 2s, 5s, and 10s times tables and beyond.
- Learn doubles and halves of numbers.
- Learn to tell the time - o'clock, half past, quarter past/to and in five minute intervals.
- Athletics - keep up to date with your activities. Try and achieve 2 silver certificates this term.
- Read Roman numerals to 100.

Writing

- Investigate prefixes and suffixes. How many do you know? How do they change the word's meaning?
- Practise the words you need to know list in your reading record.
- Keep a diary.
- Practise your handwriting, remembering to join your letters. Log in to Letter-join to practise.
- Create a rhyming poem - you can choose the theme.

Reading

- Read daily. You can access Oxford Owl for reading books for all ages. Choose a novel (or a chapter book) to read.
- Read a book and write a book review in your Home Learning book.
- Read to an adult every day.
- Write a blurb for your favourite book.
- Find unusual places to read. How many places can you find?

Geography

- Use a map to find and name the counties and major cities in the North West of England.
- Find a map of Preston and compare this to a photograph and aerial view of Preston. Talk about the differences.

Design Technology

- Plan, prepare and cook a meal/dish for your family. Remember to cook safely and work hygienically.

PE

- Make up a dance or gymnastic routine and teach your friends.
- Post any pictures of you taking part in physical activity outside school or of your achievements.

Computing

- Look for devices around the home and research input, process and output of the devices.
- Have a look for computers and network devices outside school and record your findings creatively.
