## Mathematics

- Learning 2s, 5s, and 10s times tables and beyond.
- Write your own word problems involving the four operations.
- Find real life fractions in the world around us.
- Athletics - keep up to date with your activities. Try and achieve 2 silver certificates this term.
- Measure items around the home and outdoors and compare lengths.

## Writing

- Revise word classes and present your work in a creative way. Can any words be more than one word class? Why?
- Practise the words you need to know list in your reading record.
- Write your own adventure story.
- Practise your handwriting, remembering to join your letters. Log in to Letter-join to practise.

## Reading

- Read daily. You can access Oxford Owl for reading books for all ages. Choose a novel (or a chapter book) to read.
- Create a poster for your favourite book.
- Read to an adult every day.
- Visit a library.
- Perform a rhyme or poem to a member of your family or a friend. Can you write your own?

## Music

- Compose your own piece of music using an instrument or resources from around the home.
- Use the Garage Band App to compose your own piece of music.

## Art

- Create your own Egypt inspired piece of art. This could be a sculpture, print, or anything else.
- Create your own hieroglyph.

## PE

- Throwing and catching - time yourself passing to a partner and beat your score.
- Create your own target game and write up the rules.
- Repeat a set exercise over a set period. Record your results.

## Computing

- Create a simple program on Scratch ([www.scratch.mit.edu](http://www.scratch.mit.edu)).
- Practise your programming skills on Turtle Academy ([www.turtleacademy.com](http://www.turtleacademy.com)).
