



Year 1/2 Home Learning - Summer Term 2022

Mathematics

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Practise telling the time on an analogue clock.
- ★ Have a family/friend race - can you time each race? Who came first, second, third etc?
- ★ Use measuring skills to make yourself a summer snack. This could be a smoothie, a cake - you decide!
- ★ Use a ruler to measure items around the house. Can you compare and add the measurements?
- ★ Download the Bee-Bot App to practise describing turns and position (the App is free).
- ★ Learn by heart your 2, 3, 5 and 10 multiplication tables and practise the related division facts.

English - Writing

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Write a book review for Traction Man.
- ★ Create your own super hero story - this could be a comic strip.
- ★ Write a fact file about your favourite sea creature.
- ★ Search and find your favourite photograph of the seaside and write a setting description - remember your noun phrases!
- ★ Write a postcard from the beach.
- ★ Practise your handwriting using Letter-join. Year 1s you should be practising pre cursive and Year 2s joining your letters together.

English - Reading/ Phonics

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Read your home reading books every night. Ask an adult to record it so we can change your books when needed.
- ★ How many road and street signs can you independently?
- ★ Research and read about other seaside towns in the UK.
- ★ Some children will have weekly spellings to practise for a Friday spelling quiz.

History/Geography

- ★ Research a beach that is not in England. Compare that beach to a local beach to you.
- ★ Find out about physical features of the seaside. Draw a picture and label the different features.

- You must **complete all the core activities** above (Mathematics, English and Reading)
- Select **three** of the topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting.
- **Presentation must be your best!**

Art / DT

- ★ Why don't you have a day out at the beach? Collect nature objects and create a beach sculpture.

- ★ Practise cutting, chopping and grating different foods to take on a picnic.

Science

- ★ Create a safety poster advising younger children how to stay safe at the beach. Think about what they might need, what they should be wary of and whom they should keep close to them.
- ★ Create a 'shoe box' under the sea habitat for a sea creature of your choice.

RE

- ★ Think of someone who impresses you deeply because of the way she/he lives.
- ★ What is it that impresses you? What do you think inspires them? Write about them and draw a picture.
