## Mathematics

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Explore different pairs of numbers that total to make 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.
- ★ Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10.
- ★ Learn by heart your 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables. Play times tables Rock Stars (Year 2 only).
- ★ Set up a 'play shop' with other family members. Label objects and items with prices and practise paying for 2/3 items and giving change using real coins.
- ★ Complete the activities on Mathematics and play Mathematics live. See how many certificates you can achieve this term!

## English - Writing

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Make a fact file about the moon and planets; you could use books or the internet to find out information.
- ★ Write a poem using a space word; use each letter of the word on a new line to write a poem (acrostic poem).
- ★ Write a diary for a week. Make sure you write in first person and use present tense verbs.
- ★ Practise your handwriting using Letter-join. Year 1s you should be practising pre cursive and Year 2s joining your letters together.

## English - Reading/ Phonics

(You must complete these activities)

- ★ Read your home reading books every night. Ask an adult to record it so we can change your books when needed.
- ★ Read and follow a set of instructions to make something with a member of your family.
- ★ Read some Non-Fiction books about space, famous people and inventions.
- ★ Some children will have weekly spellings to practise for a Friday spelling quiz.

## History/Geography

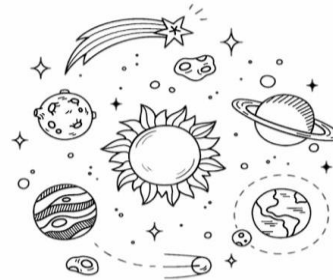
Find out about events that have happened in space. Create a timeline of them.
