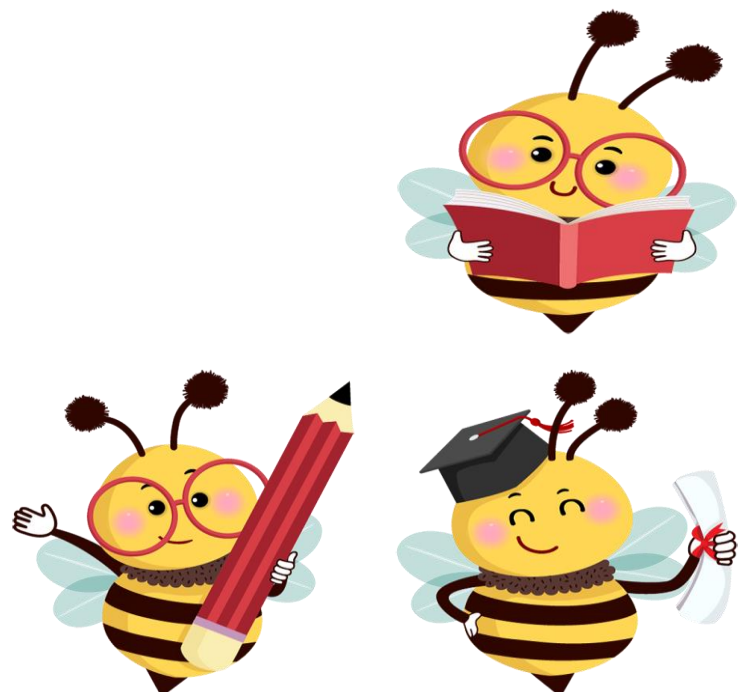
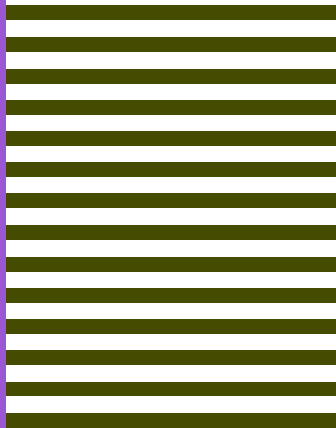
Please can we request that dogs are not brought onto the school grounds when dropping off and picking up your children.
