*“I give you repose. I revive your drooping spirit.”*

**“I am your shepherd. In relationship with me, there is nothing you shall want.”**

God is personally telling me this in this moment and in my heart I know that it is true. I take it in and I recognise it as beautiful because it is beautiful. In my heart I know that it's beautiful because it is true. And so I let my heart be accessed by God personally speaking to me in those reassuring words.

**“Fresh and green are the pastures where I give you repose.  
Near restful waters I lead you to revive your drooping spirit.”**

“What are these pastures of repose, God? Is it perhaps this relationship with the beloved, the intimate other, that this relationship is you? Is it that you are the reality in which I'm resting in the intimacy and the sweet exchanges and closeness of this relationship? Is it this child in my life? When I'm reading a child a story, there is a disarming simplicity of the child. I am reposing in you while reposing in the presence of the child or the friend: that person in whose presence I sense something; that their presence makes my life qualitatively better because of their presence in it. Are the restful waters where you revive my drooping spirit to be found in my relationship with that person, with this family, with this community?

Is it the situation that I'm in where I find a certain meaning, a certain ministry, a certain work where I'm contributing something to the human endeavour through my gifts and my abilities? Is it listening to a certain poet, the rhythms of their voice; or certain music? Is it the long slow walk to no place in particular? What are these moments? These are the moments where you give me repose, where you revive my drooping spirit. Please help me to be even more grateful and even more sensitive to this because although I know this is true in my mind as I meditate on this, it's elusive to me. It's there, but it's hard to stabilise in it. It slips away because of the distractedness of my mind and heart. Even though you are unwaveringly present in my wavering ways, my wavering ways swing so out of reach, I slip off the path. I know that my desire to stabilise in this is an echo of your desire that I might know that you are unwaveringly present.

I ask you not to break the thread of this awareness as I go through my day. I know it'll break many times, because it'll break every time I get reactive; every time I buy into the illusion that what's happening has the power to name who I am. But I know that although it breaks from my end, the thread never breaks from your end. Maybe throughout the day, in the midst of the situations of my life, as if out of the corner of my eye, I'll catch little glimpses of you, unconditionally sustaining me, guiding me, loving me.” *Adapted : James Finley. on Psalm 22*
