Mathematics

(You must complete these activities)

- Make a picture by drawing round shapes found around the house. Write their names and properties.
- There are activities on Mathletics for you to complete.
- Check Seesaw for a **Home Learning, Year 1 OR Year 2** activity to consolidate their Mathematical understanding.



English - Writing



(You must complete these activities)

- Walk somewhere in your local area. Make notes about what you can see, feel, hear and smell. Use your notes to write a description. Remember to use capital letters and full stops. To make sure your description is enjoyable for the reader, make sure you use a variety of sentence starters. If you would like lined paper, please ask your teacher.
- Learn to write your home address - remember to only share this with your trusted adults.
- Go on Letter-join and practise 'harder letters' and 'easy words' - wk9133 home.
- Check Seesaw for a **Home Learning, Writing** activity to consolidate their full stops and capital letters.



English - Reading



(You must complete these activities)

- Log onto Oxford Owl, read an eBook.
- Visit your local library and post a picture on Seesaw!
- Read to someone you have never read to before.
- Read about our local area; discover what places there are to visit on our doorstep.
- Draw a picture of your favourite book character and write some sentences about them. Think about what they look like, what they think and how they feel.
- Read your library book somewhere you've never read before.
- EVERYDAY - read your home reading book and record your reading in your reading record.



Science

Create a picture/model of the bones in your body. You can bring this into school to show your friends. Can you label the parts? You could ask a trusted adult to take a photograph of your body (head to toe) and you could label it.

ART

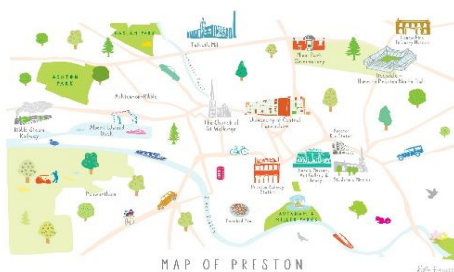
Draw a self-portrait! Use a variety of resources to create your masterpiece - paints, pencil, maybe even technology!
