Nasal Flu Vaccinations – Thursday, 30th November

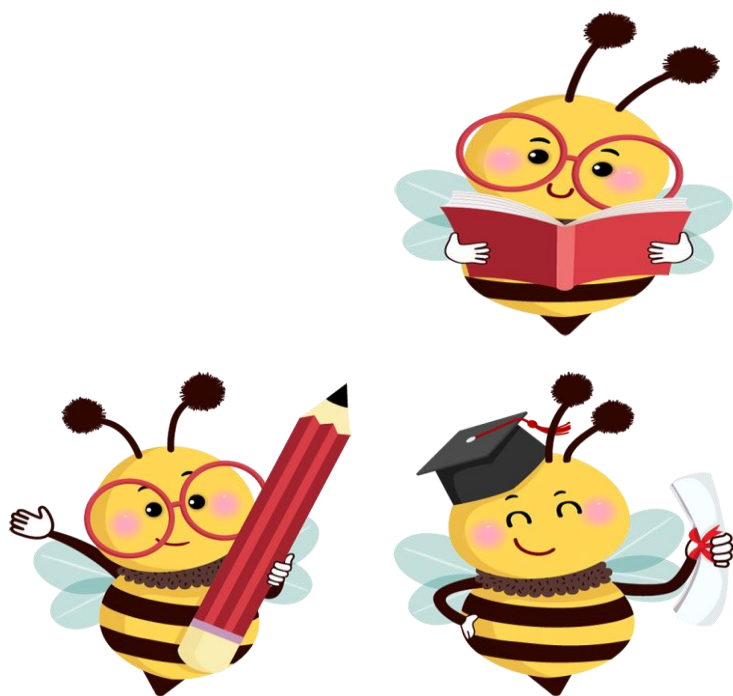
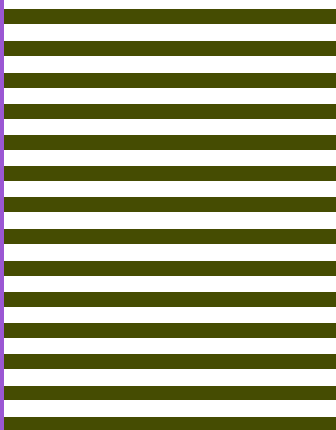
