school, we have recently had a visit from a Fairtrade representative. Janette Fletcher delivered a presentation all about Fairtrade. She talked to the children about the Fairtrade

products we can purchase and those products using Fairtrade composites; alongside information about the history of Fairtrade and a breakdown of how much of the purchase Fairtrade price, Fairtrade farmers actually receive once everyone else takes their cut!

We have been invited to support Preston's 20th year anniversary project by designing Fairtrade eggs that will be displayed in Preston during the Easter break, so our Fairtrade Warriors are currently busy being very creative! We look forward to sharing these creations with you!

#### **School Hoodies**

We have had a number of enquiries about hooded tops. To clarify, hooded tops, including those with the school logo, are permitted in school but cannot be worn for PE lessons involving invasion games and tag games for safety reasons. As indicated in our PE policy, children should wear a blue/black hoodless jumper/sweatshirt on PE days so that they can keep warm during PE lessons when the weather is cold.
